LICENSING UPDATES

Perth: Alara Resources Limited (ASX: AUQ) (**Alara** or **Company**) is pleased to provide the following udpates in respect to licensing of its joint venture projects in Oman and Saudi Arabia.

WASHIHI COPPER-GOLD PROJECT IN OMAN

Alara has joint venture interests in five copper-gold deposits located within four Exploration Licences¹ in Oman extending over 692km².

Al Hadeetha Resources LLC², which holds three of these Exploration Licences, has also submitted a mining licence application for the Washihi copper-gold project and is working with relevant government authorities to ensure all licensing requirements are satisfied.

The Company is pleased to report that 'no objection' notices have been received from the Ministry of Water, local council and municipal authorities, Ministry of Tourism, Ministry of Roads & Transport, Ministry of Commerce & Industry, Ministry of Defence, Royal Oman Police, Pollution Control Board, Ministry of Manpower and Planning, and Ministry of Finance and Taxes. Officials from the Ministry of Environment have also visited the site in recent months as part of their assessment process.

Once all 'no objection' notices have been issued, the mining authority will be in a position to make a final determination regarding the Washihi mining licence application. Further updates will be given in due course.

Alara recognises and expresses appreciation for the conscientious approach taken by the relevant authorities and its joint venture partners in connection with the progress outlined above. The high level of local support for the project is also noteworthy and is largely attributed to the positive relationship between community leaders and the principal of Al Hadeetha Investments LLC (a division of the Al Naba Group).

KHNAIGUUIYAH ZINC-COPPER PROJECT IN SAUDI

Government authorities have taken steps to suspend operations at the Khnaiguiyah Zinc-Copper project site due to expiry of the environmental licence held by Alara's joint venture partner Manajem.

The Company considers renewal of Manajem's environmental licence to be unlikely while the project remains at an impasse³.

This development was foreshadowed in the recent Prospectus⁴ and is not harmful to Alara's interests given Alara has not been active at the site for over a year.

The ultimate effect of this development on the legal dispute⁵ between Manajem and Alara is yet to be seen. While the possibility of settlement with Manajem cannot be dismissed, the Company has also prepared for contingencies⁶ by establishing alternative means for advancing the Khnaiguiyah Zinc-Copper project to production, while continuing to assert its rights under the Khnaiguiyah Shareholders' Agreement.
